## 2018 SENIOR SUMMIT PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Students must show respect for EAOP staff, Student Mentors, presenters and your peers at ALL TIMES.
- Students must follow ALL directions given by EAOP Staff, presenters, and Student Mentors.
- Students must attend ALL presentations and activities including meals.
- Students must stay with their assigned group at ALL TIMES.
- Eating, drinking and/or chewing gum is NOT allowed during presentations and activities.
- Use of Mp3s, iPods, iPads, laptops, computers, or cell phones is NOT allowed during presentation and activities.
- Students are to maintain their key on them at all times. Keys are not transferable; use of the key by anyone other than the person to whom it is issued is strictly prohibited. (Important Note: There will be a \$50.00 replacement fee charged to the student for lost keys).
- Students must sleep in assigned rooms. There is absolutely no room switching.
- Students must leave their residence hall window closed and locked at all times for safety and energy conservation.
- Students must be quiet and in their room by curfew time. (Important Note: EAOP Staff will be doing walk-throughs periodically throughout the night. Students not found in their assigned rooms will be sent home immediately).
- Students must NOT prop their door open as doing so is against fire regulations.
- Students must NEVER tamper or misuse fire alarms, when no fire or threat exists. (Important Note: Any student caught setting off a false alarm will be charged **\$1,500.00** by the Riverside Fire Department and will be sent home immediately).
- The use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or drugs is PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES. (Important Note: Any student caught in the possession of, association with, or under the influence of such substances will be sent home immediately.)
- Vandalism, damage, or destruction of University or personal property is not permitted. (Important Note: Bills for the cost of repair, including both parts and labor, will be charged to the student found responsible).
- Students must NOT engage in inappropriate public displays of affection.
- Both direct and indirect forms of verbal and written abuse, threats, coercion, physical or verbal harassment, intimidation, stalking, bullying, unwanted personal contact, violence against another person or their property, or causing the apprehension of physical or verbal harm are PROHIBITED AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. (Important Note: Parents will be notified and students will be sent home immediately and prohibited from participating in future events)
- Privacy is respected. However, authorized personnel may enter a student's room for reasons of health, safety, general welfare, or maintenance. You will always be given advance notice of any such action UNLESS there are exceptional circumstances, such as personal safety, noise levels, or illegal activity.
