Junior Timeline

OCTOBER

- Sign up and take the PSAT

NOVEMBER

- Use your PSAT score to identify challenging areas for the SAT
- Ask your counselor about fee waivers for the ACT and SAT

DECEMBER

- Sign up for EAOP Campus Tours

JANUARY

- Calculate “a-g” GPA

FEBRUARY

- Make a list of campuses you are interested in applying to
- Take a tour of local campuses

MARCH

- Attend EAOP Campus Tour
- Start studying for AP exams

APRIL

- Review your Senior class schedule with your counselor to maintain rigor
