# Pell Grant: Federal Financial Aid

## Requirements:

- For undergraduates with financial need who have not earned Bachelor or professional degree
- A student can receive a Federal Pell Grant for NO MORE than 12 semesters or the equivalent (roughly 6 years)

## What it entitles:

Awards can be up to **\$5,775** per year



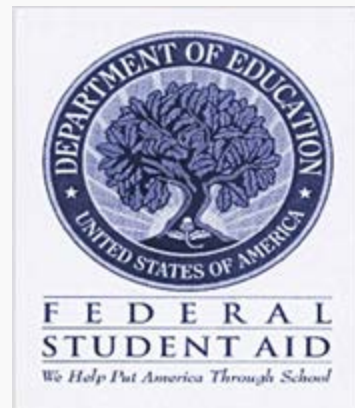
# Pell Grant: Ayuda financiera federal

## Requisitos:

- Para los estudiantes de pregrado con necesidad económica que no han ganado licenciatura o título profesional
- Un estudiante puede recibir una Beca Federal Pell durante **no más de 12 semestres** o su equivalente (aproximadamente 6 años)

## Lo que Autoriza:

Premios pueden ser hasta **\$5,775** por año



# Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)

Undergraduate students

# Cal Grants: State Financial Aid

- Gift aid for students attending a **CA college or university**
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Must have a **minimum 2.0 GPA**
- Apply with FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application



- Ayuda para estudiantes que asisten a un **colegio o universidad de CA**
- Debe demostrar necesidad financiera
- Debe tener un promedio de grado **mínimo de 2.0**
- Aplicar a través de FAFSA o CA Dream Act

## CAL GRANT A

- CSU: Up to **\$5,742**
- UC: Up to **\$12,570**
- Private 4-year: Up to **\$9,084**
- Cannot receive at a Community College until transfer to 4-year university
- Minimum GPA: **3.0**

## CAL GRANT B

- CCC: Up to **\$1,672**
- 4-year universities: **Same as Cal Grant A** amounts + \$1,672
- Minimum GPA: **2.0**

## CAL GRANT C

- Occupational, technical, or vocational programs
- Between **\$547 - \$2,462** for books, tools, and equipment
- Program must be 4 months long

# Middle Class Scholarship

## *Beca de clase media*

### Requirements:

- Must be enrolled at a UC or CSU
- Must be enrolled at least half time
- First Undergraduate program
- Must have income of \$171,000 or less

### Requisitos:

- Asistir a una UC o CSU
- Debe estar inscrito/a al menos medio tiempo
- Primer programa de licenciatura
- Debe tener un ingreso de \$171,000 o menos

### What it entitles:

- UC maximum award amount **\$5,052**
- CSU maximum award amount **\$2,298**





# Chafee Grant

## *Beca Chafee*

Assists current or former foster youth that were dependent or wards of the court for at least 1 day between ages of 16 and 18

Beginning in 2018-19, the Chafee Grant can be renewed until age of 26 (previously 23 years of age)

It entitles up to **\$5,000** per academic year

# Work-Study

## *Trabajo-Estudio*

**Federal Work-Study** provides part-time jobs for undergraduate and graduate students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay education expenses. The program encourages community service work and work related to the student's course of study.

**El Programa Federal de Estudio y Trabajo** brinda empleos a tiempo parcial para estudiantes de pregrado y posgrado con una necesidad económica, lo cual les permite ganar dinero que los ayuda a pagar los gastos de estudio.

## *Becas*

Free money awarded by private companies, agencies, and/or foundations; awards, deadlines, and requirements may vary

Dinero gratis otorgado por empresas privadas, organismos y fundaciones; premios, los plazos y los requisitos pueden variar

# Student Loans

## *Préstamos Estudiantiles*

If you apply for financial aid, you may be offered loans as part of your school's **financial aid offer**. A loan is money you borrow and must pay back with **interest**.

# Financial Aid Applications

## *Aplicaciones de ayuda financiera*

### FAFSA

#### Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- Apply online at **[www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)**
- Begin applying as early as **October 1st** (Senior Year)
- Priority deadline **March 2nd**
- One application for all financial aid
- Qualify for federal and state aid



Or

### DREAM

#### CA Dream Act Application

- Apply online at **[www.dream.csac.ca.gov](http://www.dream.csac.ca.gov)**
- **AB 540 eligible students:**
  - Attended a CA high school for at least three years
  - Earn diploma or GED in CA
  - Register and enroll in a college/university
  - Filed an affidavit with the institution student plans to attend
- Qualify for **state-funded** aid

# Base on student Immigration status will determine which financial aid application needs to be fill out

Fill out the **FAFSA** if student has one of the following status:

- US Citizen
- Permanent Resident (Student has a “Green Card”)
- T- VISA

**Parents without SSN enter: 000-00-0000 in the FAFSA**

Or

Fill out the **CA Dream Act** Application if student qualifies under one of the following status:

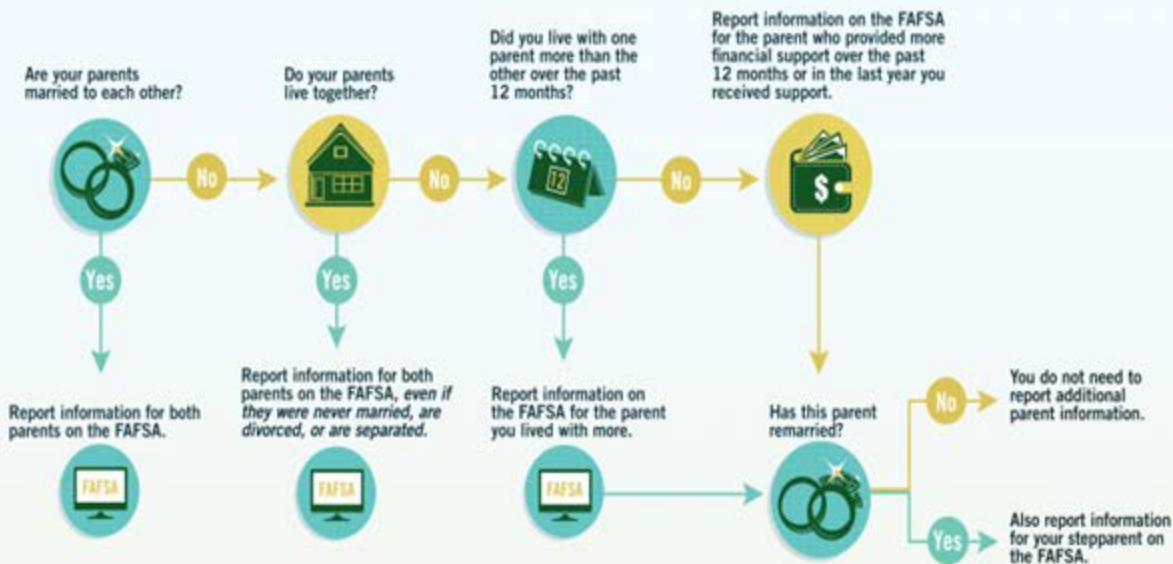
- Undocumented students who qualify under **AB540** status
- U-VISA
- **DACA Status** (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals)
- Students have been granted a “Working SSN” to work for two years in the US and apply for a CA ID/Driver License.

**Parents without SSN enter: 000-00-0000 in the CA Dream Act**

# WHO'S MY PARENT WHEN I FILL OUT MY FAFSA?

Dependent students are required to report parent information on the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)*.<sup>1</sup> For reporting purposes, "PARENT" means your legal (biological or adoptive) parent or stepparent, or a person that the state has determined to be your legal parent.

Use this guide to figure out which parent's information to include (depending on your family situation).



The following people are not your parents unless they have legally adopted you:



Widowed Stepparent



Grandparents



Foster Parents



Legal Guardians



Older Brothers or Sisters



Aunts or Uncles

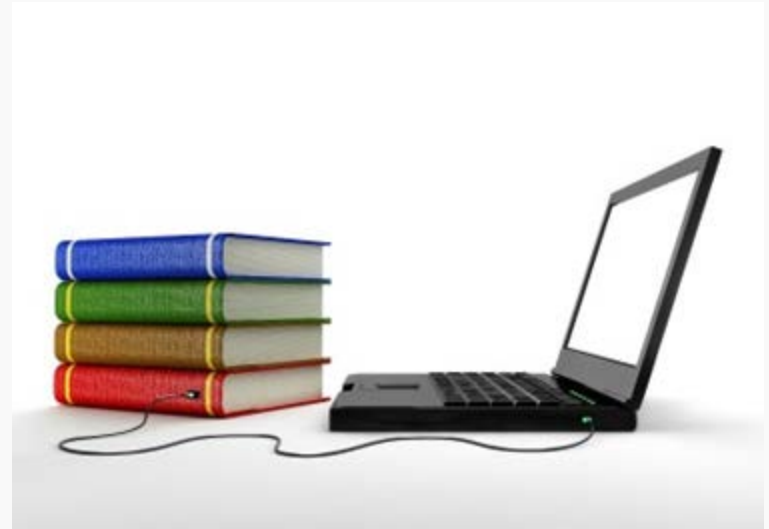

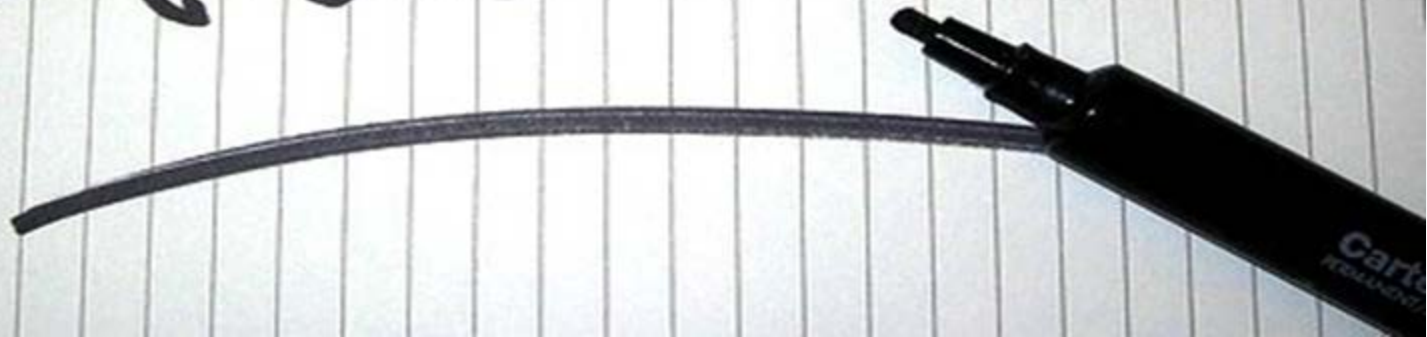
