- 4) If money and skill were not factors, what would be my dream job?

Essential Questions to Ask Yourself When Deciding on a Major:

- 1) Is this major broad enough to apply to more than one field?
- 2) What are the career and job opportunities for this major?
- 3) Can I picture myself working in this field for the next 10-30 years?
- 4) What are the course requirements for this major?
- 5) Will I need to pursue a graduate degree in this field?
- 6) Will this major lead me to a job that fits my lifestyle?

Essential Questions to Ask Yourself When Deciding on a Career:

- 1) What are the responsibilities for someone in this career field?
- 2) What education and training is needed for this career?
- 3) What are the required skills and qualifications for this career?
- 4) What are some important characteristics for people in this career to have?
- 5) What is the average salary for someone in this career field? (Consider national and local averages)
- 6) How do additional degree or qualifications affect salaries in this field?
